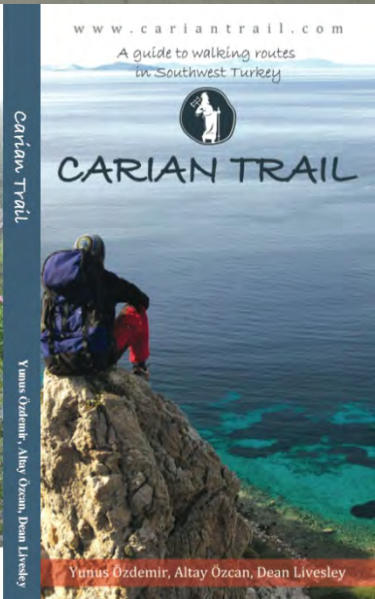
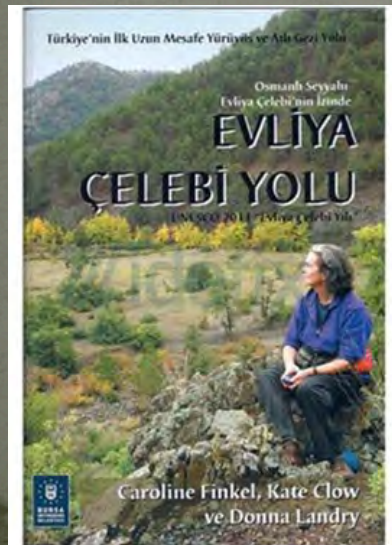
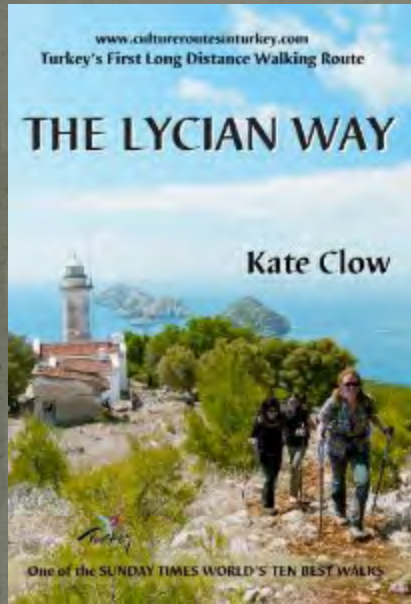

Europe to Turkey on Foot Project

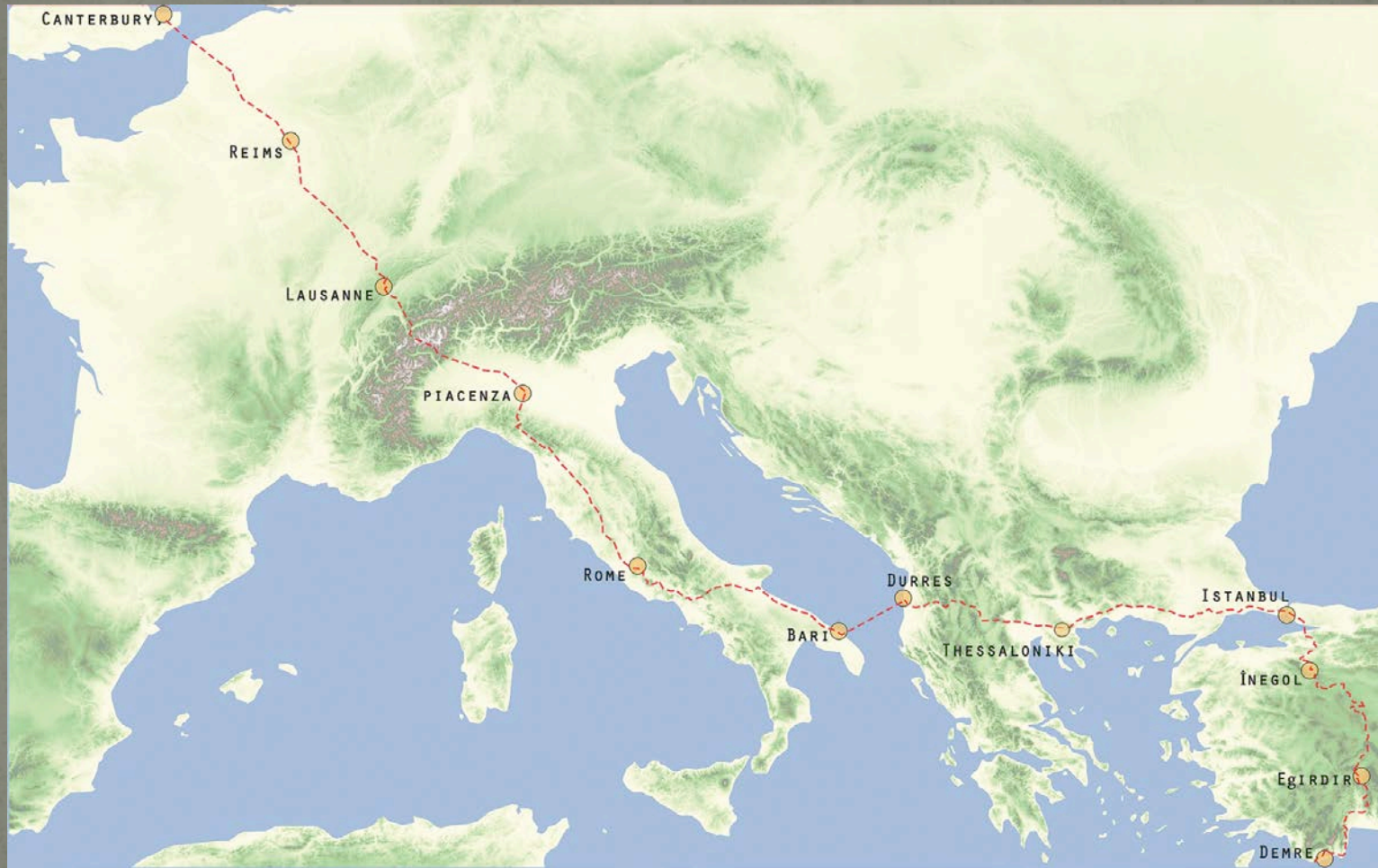
- Civil Society Dialogue (financed by EU and Republic of Turkey)

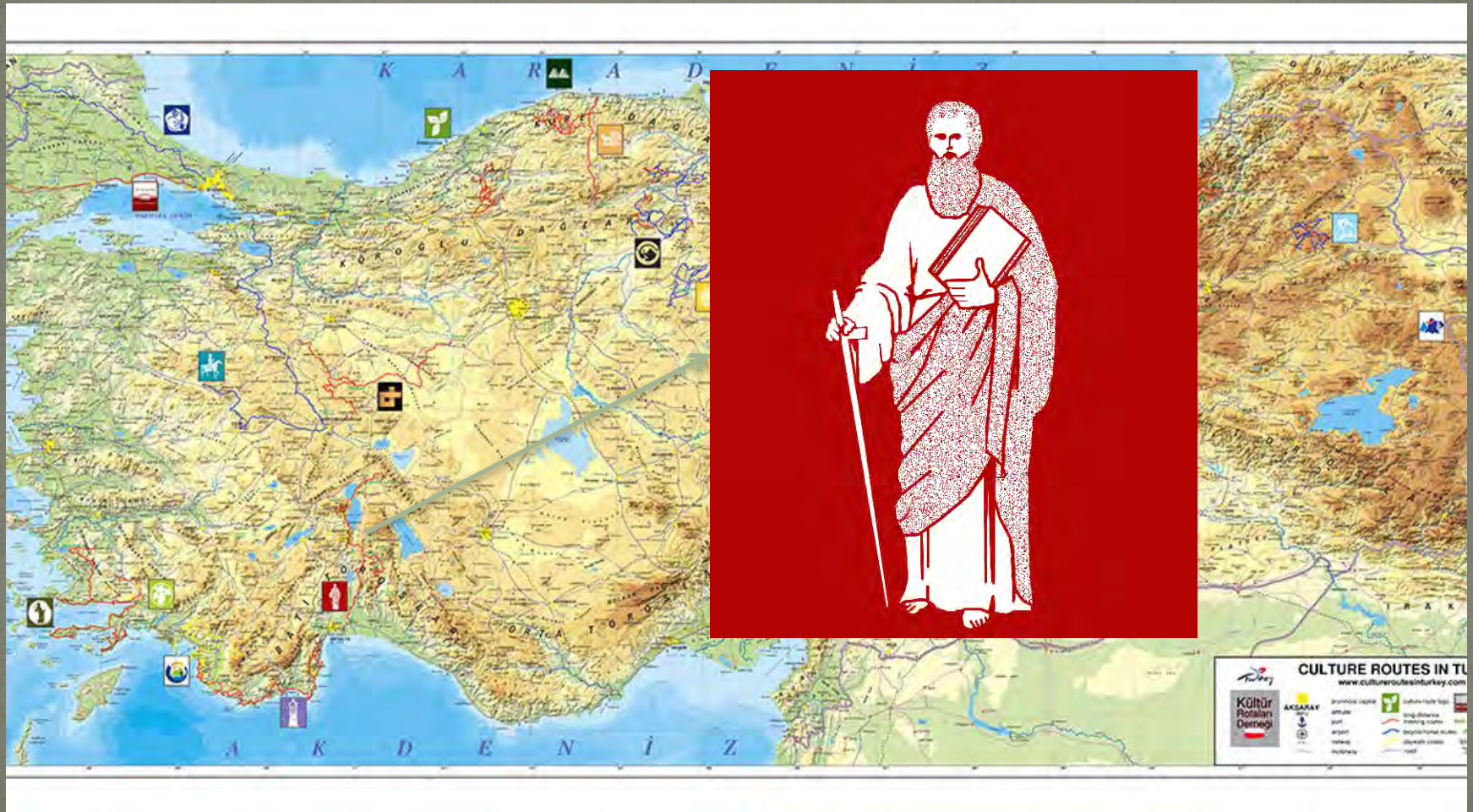
Evliya Çelebi Way

 - allow villagers to participate in sustainable tourism as a stimulus to rural development.





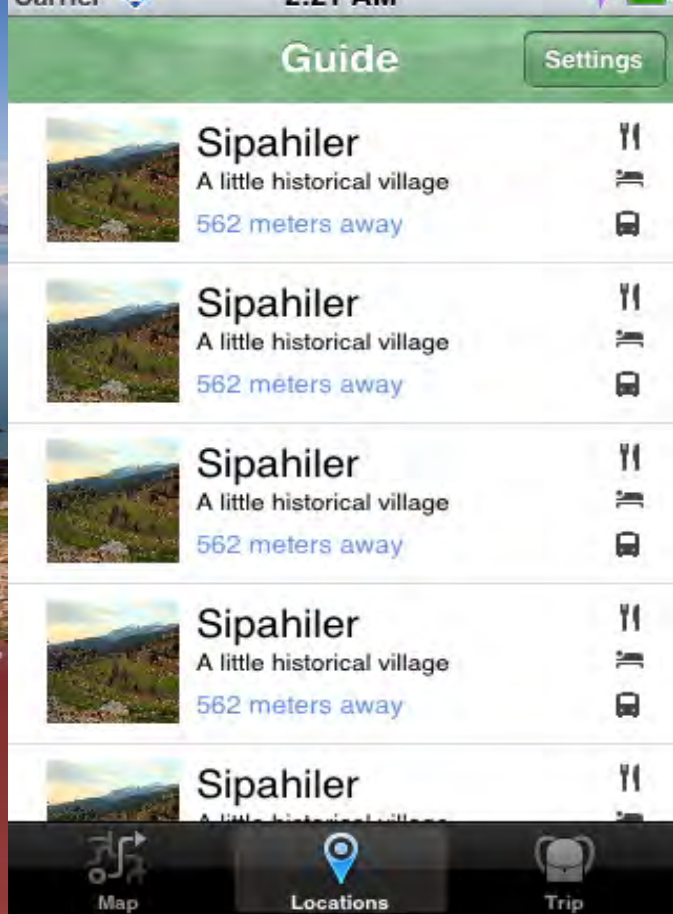
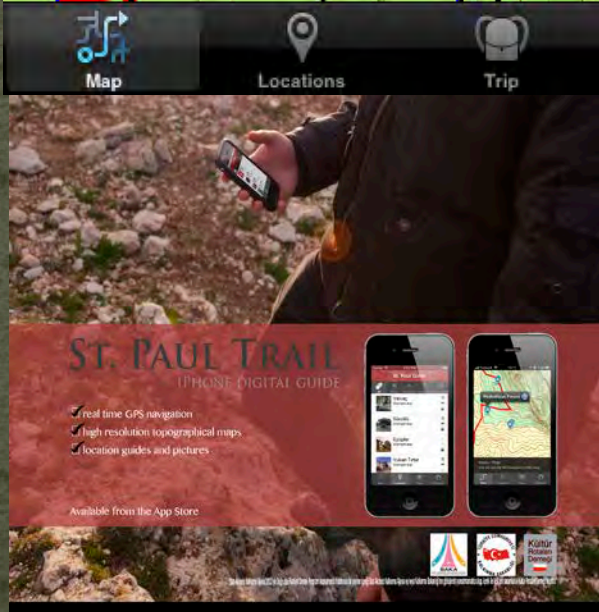
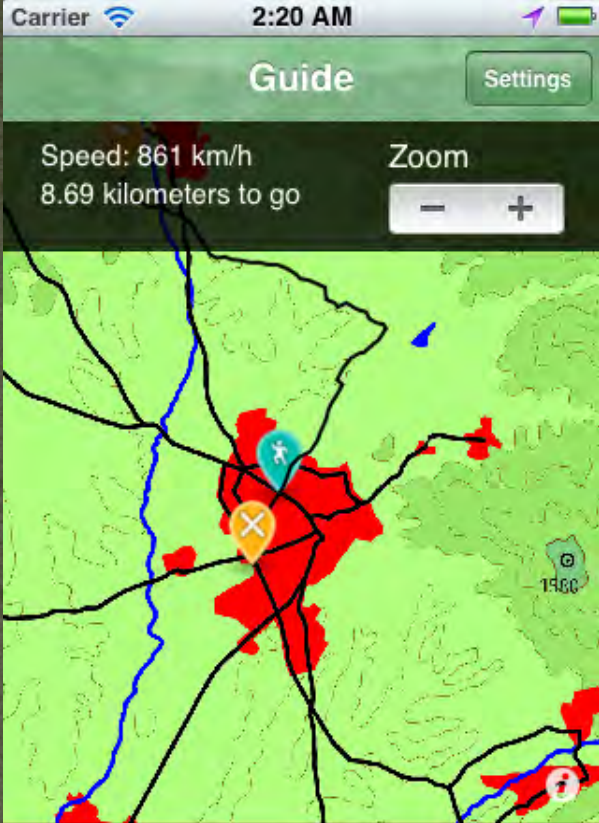
