Pacific Slope Trail– Bruce Trail Friendship Trail



This section of the Bruce Trail is twinned with the section of the Pacific Slope Trail (*Sendero Pacífico*) leading into the Children’s Eternal Rain Forest in Costa Rica. The Pacific Slope Trail Network is a vision shared by an informal association of individuals, community groups, and organizations who wish to link forests and rural communities along Costa Rica’s Pacific Slope via a freely accessible trail system.



Like the Bruce Trail, the Pacific Slope Trail depends heavily on the participation and energy of many volunteers. The trail begins in the famous Monteverde Cloud Forest conservation region and encompasses a network of trail systems, huts, conservation properties, ecological agriculture initiatives, alternative energy, wastewater treatment and water conservation projects.

The Bruce Trail Conservancy has opened Friendship Trails with conservation and hiking organizations in countries around the world including South Korea, Lebanon, England, Wales and South Africa.

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


