


Former JNR Kurayoshi Line Tracks Trekking Course

Length Approx. 3.5 km **Time** Approx. 1 hr., 6 min.
Calories burned Approx. 167 kcal (1 frankfurter)

The Japanese National Railways Kurayoshi Line was founded as the "Kurayoshi Keiben Line" in 1912, but abandoned in 1985 due to factors like the growing popularity of owning personal cars. Today, the abandoned tracks have been given new life and are maintained as a walking course. The portion from Sekigane to Yamamori particularly retains rails, platforms, and tunnel area, and was refitted about a decade ago to become an "abandoned track trekking course" of the kind rarely seen across the rest of Japan. It is amazingly popular.



To enter the Yamamori Tunnel from Taikyujii Station onward, you must join a tour or participate in an open day. Go for a walk through the mystical bamboo forest and tunnel space while listening to explanations from an expert guide.
