PICK UP -1 Matsuba Crab

Season November to March

Season Late August to late September

Installation of arrows and warning signs

Arrows and bicycle pictograms have been installed on the left side of the roadway so that you can cycle safely and without losing your way along the Tottori Uminami Road. Road markings and signboards have also been installed in areas requiring attention.


Mikuriya Fishing Port
