Tottori City

There is no shortage of things to see and do in Tottori City. Formed over tens of thousands of years, the Tottori Sand Dunes are a natural work of art in their own right. There's even The Sand Museum, featuring sculptures made only from sand and water! Other great spots include the Tottori Castle Ruins, the feudal-era castle that was worth 320,000 koku (almost 48,000 tons of rice) in its time; Hakuto Shrine, the location in Japan's first love story involving two deities; and the Karoichi Market, known as "Tottori's Kitchen".



Yonago

One of the best hot spring spots in the Sanin region, with outstanding views of the Sea of Japan and the breathtaking Mt. Daisen. Kaike Onsen is one of the only hot springs in Japan that originates from the sea and is renowned for its health and beauty benefits. In the city center you'll find the Yonago Castle Ruins, a National Historic Site, where you can enjoy a panoramic view of the city from the tower ruins.



Judo
